



# About the Commonwealth Teaching Scholarships

The Commonwealth Teaching Scholarships Program supports new undergraduate and postgraduate teacher education students with scholarships of up to \$40,000 (for undergraduate students) or up to \$20,000 (for postgraduate students).

In return for a scholarship, recipients need to teach in government schools or government-run early learning settings in Australia after finishing their degree. <u>Find out more about eligibility and requirements</u>.

If you're a new undergraduate or postgraduate student, commencing an accredited teaching degree in the first semester or study period of 2026 and you will be studying full-time, you may be eligible for a Commonwealth Teaching Scholarship.

Scholarships are worth up to \$40,000 for undergraduate and up to \$20,000 for postgraduate students. If you are successful in gaining a scholarship you will be required to teach for up to four years full-time equivalent for an undergraduate degree and up to two years full-time equivalent for a postgraduate degree, after you graduate. You can teach in any government school or government-run early learning setting in Australia, to meet your Commitment to Teach obligation.

Undergraduates can receive up to \$40,000 Postgraduates can receive up to \$20,000

#### Who can apply?

To apply you must be living in Australia and:

- an Australian citizen
- a permanent resident
- a holder of a permanent humanitarian visa; or
- a New Zealand citizen.

In return for your scholarship, you must be willing to commit to teaching for up to four years (undergraduate) or up to two years (postgraduate) in a government school or government-run early learning setting in Australia.

# Commonwealth Teaching Scholarships

#### Round 3

Undergraduate and postgraduate students, who are starting an accredited teaching degree in the first semester or study period of 2026, may be eligible for a Commonwealth Teaching Scholarship.

The Australian Government has committed to providing scholarships of up to \$40,000 for new full-time undergraduate teaching students and up to \$20,000 for new full-time postgraduate teaching students. Up to 1,000 scholarships per year will be offered over five years.

As part of the scholarship, recipients must commit to teach in government schools or government-run early learning settings in Australia for a period of time after graduating. Recipients will have 10 years to fulfil their Commitment to Teach obligation.

Applications are strongly encouraged from high-achieving school leavers, mid-career professionals, First Nations peoples, people for whom English is an additional language or dialect, people with disability, people from regional, rural or remote locations and people from low socio-economic backgrounds, who aspire to embark on a rewarding career in teaching.
